SALESPERSON OF THE YEAR

Recognizes an outstanding sales professional who consistently achieves strong results while demonstrating integrity, professionalism, and a commitment to serving clients well.

EXCEPTIONAL SERVICE

Recognizes a client-facing professional who consistently goes above and beyond to deliver exceptional service, build strong relationships, and create a positive experience for those they serve.

EMERGING LEADER

Recognizes a rising professional with fewer than five years in the association who is already demonstrating meaningful leadership, initiative, and engagement. Nominees should be actively contributing to NABIP's future while showing leadership within their own organization or professional community.

OUTSTANDING MEMBER

Recognizes a NABIP Michigan member whose consistent involvement strengthens the association. Nominees are dependable volunteers who step up, follow through, support association programs and events, and actively help grow and engage the NABIP community.

ADVOCATE OF THE YEAR

Recognizes a member who demonstrates exceptional commitment to advocacy on behalf of the health insurance and benefits profession.

Nominees actively engage in legislative and grassroots efforts, serve as trusted resources for policymakers and fellow members, and support initiatives such as CapCon, Legislative Day, the PAC, and Operation Shout.

LEADERSHIP EXCELLENCE

Recognizes a professional whose leadership inspires, empowers, and elevates others within the health insurance and benefits industry. Nominees demonstrate vision, integrity, and a sustained commitment to strengthening their team, their profession, and the mission of NABIP Michigan.

Honors a longtime NABIP member whose career reflects sustained service to the health insurance and benefits industry. Nominees should have at least 15 years of industry experience, 10 or more years of NABIP membership, and a demonstrated history of contributing their time, talent, and resources to advance the profession.
